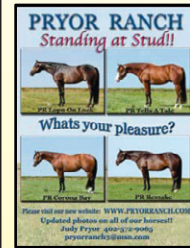


Every One Has A Story!

We find we have all been blessed to have a special horse in our lives and discovered that each of us have built our world around our sire and the promotion of his offspring. This year during the All-American Quarter Horse Congress join DeGraff Stables, Pryor Ranch, Ironwood Acres, Seabreeze Pleasure Horses, Painted Pines Ranch and Sure Grip Farm in Congress Hall at Booth #405! We have several great stories to tell and seek to include you in the stallion progeny legacys we are building!

Yes... you could say that we all are a little crazy. About horses that is. Developing our bloodlines required not only passion, conviction and determination to keep going, but mostly, a strong belief in the horse. Our faith in our vision of what we believed the stallion would become encouraged us to work hard at it so their offspring could turn into what they are today: athletic, willing to please and competitive.

Talk about a story! Imagine getting a phone call advising you that your favorite horse had just become for sale, and, with no prior breeding experience, Judy believed she should take the chance and said; "SOLD"! She put the purchase



price of the stallion on six credit cards in order to pay for him. All this because she wanted to show her friends she could 'do it', even though they thought she couldn't! Well... Judy did. Deck Of Stars was never ridden in a show and neither were two of his top producing sons; Duplicated Deck or BMQ Legacy. Yet Deck's incredible heritage provided for Pryor Ranch earning 37 multi-breed World and Reserve World Championships, a Supreme Champion, AQHA Champions, an AQHA Reserve High Point and many Superiors. Deck Of Stars sired 715 foals that earned 15,102.5 points and earned \$141,734 in Incentive Fund Earnings and \$10,964 in World Show earnings; all with the owners training their horse and enjoying the ride themselves! Judy's special mares produced These Irons Are Hot, BR I Am, A Beautiful Ride, BR Tiger Talk and Samanthas Choice. She now continues with her young stallions: PR Remake, PR Tells A Tale, PR Lopn On Luck and PR Corona Bay.

Riding to the practice arena for warm-up for an equitation class, Robin saw a gorgeous yearling standing outside the barn. Recognizing him as the picture of the perfect horse image that she had carried in her head since she was little, led her to purchase of Indian Artifacts on the spot. What a ride! An AQHA World Championship, two Congress Reserve Championships, an AQHA Superior and multiple Open and Non-Pro Championships capped an extensive show career. Today he is the only breeding stallion with an AQHA World Title and an AWR Inspection Championship. Each foal of his that have been submitted for scoring and evaluation prior to registration with the AWR have ALL outscored their dams; thus demonstrating that he improves the breed. Indian Artifacts has sired World or Reserve World, National and Inspection Champions in five breeds and the NSBA. His offspring have won USEF, USDF and AWR year end awards and many circuit championships in USHJA competitions. They have excelled in Hunter Under Saddle, Over Fence, Longe Line, All-Around events, Hunter Breeding, Dressage and Eventing. Robin states that Indian Artifacts is truly "WhatIWork4".



Ironwood Acres boasts leading sons of Zippos Mr Goodbar and A Sudden Impulse. MDR Impulsive (AQHA/APHA) was homebred and Frosty The Goodbar was found as a weanling. Donna and Heinie Hendley knew they had great ones from the start. Collectively these great stallions are sires of multiple World and Reserve World Champions, Top Five and Top Ten placers and Finalists, as well as Qualifiers for the Select World, AQHA Youth World, NSBA World, APHA World, APHA Youth World, Pinto World, Quarter, Paint, and Pinto Congress. They have also sired APHA Honor Roll Leaders, Futurity Champions and Reserve Champions in Western Pleasure and Longe Line in both AQHA and APHA. Earners of Superiors and ROMs in WP, HUS, Equitation, Horsemanship, Showmanship, Halter, Trail, and Western Riding in Open, Amateur, Youth, and Novice Divisions of AQHA, APHA, and PtHA. 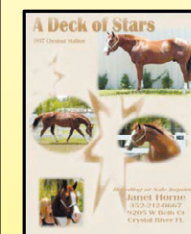


the opportunity to own the double registered AQHA/APHA stallion; MDR Impulsive and add this impressive stallion's genetic pool to your breeding operation.

With the help of Stanley Scott, Hes A Cool Hotrod (AQHA/APHA) was acquired. Crowned an unanimous APHA World Champion and excitingly, his first full crop of foals produced two APHA World Champions; Shes Perfectly Hot and Hands Off My Hotrod, and the Top Five finisher – Hes A Special Hotrod! This year, Hes Perfectly Hot is #2 on the APHA Honor Roll in Open HUS with Kate Emnet and is #7 in Open Green Western Pleasure with Drew Emmett. What a start to this leading son of Certain Potential's career as a sire! Awesome! Mark and Carrie are equally proud of their second stallion; Hot Lopin Sensation. An APHA Reserve World Champion and Superior earner in Junior Western Pleasure, by NSBA Hall of Fame Inductee; Zippos Sensation, we invite you to watch for his first foals to enter the show ring! We also congratulate Amanda Nickerson who currently is in the Top 5 APHA All-Around events for 13 and under and #1 in Zone 7.



Standing at DeGraff Stables is 5X World Champion and multiple World Champion sire HBF Iron Man (AQHA/APHA)! HBF Iron Man, with five Titles in five attempts, is the only breeding stallion today whom is an APHA World Champion in both Hunter Under Saddle and in Western Pleasure. He earned multiple Superiors with 923 points in 7 events, over \$20,000 in Futurity winnings, an AQHA ROM and an AQHA World Show Qualification in Senior HUS. Beginning with his first foal crop, he has sired multiple APHA and PtHA World and Reserve World Champions. HBF Iron Man is the leading double registered sire of hunter under saddle horses for APHA! Indian Artifacts and HBF Iron Man are joined by two DeGraff Stables homebreds; Futurity Champion and earner of \$16,000, DGS IndyGo (Indian Artifacts X Taking Invitations) whom is homozygous for the black gene and DGS Vestastic (Vested Pine X Krymsun Hot Invite-Full Sister to One Hot Krymsun).



Janet Horne of Sure Grip Farm states that Judy Pryor was her mentor growing up. Janet owns A Deck Of Stars an own son of Deck Of Stars. A duplicate of his sire, he was so stunning even as a yearling. During Jan's ownership he has sired many offspring with the same calm demeanor and intelligence. They have been successful in all modalities, including barrel racing, calf roping, jumping, western pleasure and trail.
